At present, the most influential theory is Inglehart's intergenerational value theory. The theory holds that with the transition from modern society to post-modern society, the values of the public have changed from materialistic values focusing on "Economic and personal security" to Post-materialism values focusing on "Self-expression and quality of life".

Compared with the foreign researchers' in-depth study of vocational values, and has formed some related theories, the theoretical circles of our country started the study of vocational values late. Typically, some people, represented by Ling Wenshuan, think that vocational values are the embodiment of values in the process of employment. It is a kind of attitude and belief that people treat occupation, also can be said to be a kind of value orientation that people show in professional life³. However, in the opinion of Yu Hua, professional values are the standard yardstick for people to measure the quality and importance of a certain profession in society. (3) Self-centered, lack of Collective Consciousness
