Development and Utilization of Local Characteristic Culture in Community Education

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Abstract: This article focuses on the integration and inheritance of local characteristic culture in community education. Through the combination of theoretical analysis and empirical investigation, this article discusses the importance, challenges, development strategies and practical effects of local characteristic culture in community education. 


Figure 1 Characteristics of local characteristic culture

5. Conclusions
